### Attendance Module tested & Trial Implementation in ABMR COP

Software based attendance management system is developed by HESDAR center in collaboration with Star Knowledge Mysuru. It includes attendance capturing by faculty & checking by students on real time basis on the smart devices or computer. Students can check attendance only of the courses registered. The software covers all courses of B Pharm program & for concerned students & faculty. Percent attendance, shortage, date etc. can be checked.

The software is password protected & can be accesses on college web portal. Reports which are tailor made can be generated as required in a short time. It also has edit & other flexible features. The software has been found useful & effective by faculty & students of the college and has received good feedback & excellent review. There is no investment by the college on hardware, equipment or server, as the software is Google Cloud based. It eliminates repetitive work, saves faculty & student time and information is available at finger tips on real time.

Software is being developed for other Modules namely Assessments, Learning, Teaching, Research, Leave & Security, Collaboration etc.
