#### Award of certificates in Strategic Education Practices & Digital Technology

26 faculty members of Acharya Institutes College of Pharmacy, Bengaluru successfully completed the Skill development modules under "Strategic Education Practices & Digital Technology, conducted by HESDAR Center, Mysuru. About 15 modules were completed in workshop format with pre & posttests, discussions, presentations & active learning. Each work shop was for 4 hrs with total of 60 contact hrs. Formative assessments – quiz, assignment, mid-modules and summative assessment – end modules exams were conducted. Feed- back was given to participants to improve their performance in competency & communication. It involved computer based tests, reviews and hard copy based feed-back. Certificates were distributed on 8th Sept. 2018 during a special function.



# Free Dental Camp & medicine distribution for School Children at Yarazari, Vijayapur, Karnataka

A free dental camp was organized by Aadeeshwar Jain Education Trust (AJET), Mysuru at Yarazari village, Muddebihal-Tq, Vijayapura-Dt, Karnataka on 18th August 2018 (Saturday). Camp was conducted as the Government School for the benefit of children. Doctors were provided with independent space for checking & other facilities for waiting school children.

Twelve (12) qualified & experienced dental doctors from Bagalkot, were engaged in the free checkup of children. Mobile dental van with all the facilities was available for the camp. This was the first kind of program for children in the village in several years. Free medicines & mouth wash were distributed to all the needy children. Common problems were, dental caries, rotten tooth, gum problem, non-brushing etc. 10 to 15 % of the children & elders were referred to dental hospital in Bagalkot for further checkup & treatment.

442 children from 1st to 8th standard & 25 elders were checked by dental doctors after formal enrollment and were prescribed medicines as required. Medicines & mouth wash were distributed free of cost to the patients.

Dr. Anand Hiremath, Dr. Akkamahadevi & 10 dental interns participated in the camp. Dr. Rajendra C Nagavi, coordinated the camp. We thank Dr. Srinivas Vanaki- Principal, PMNM Dental College Bagalkot for the support.

The program was conducted with the help of Village school HM, other teachers & village leaders, Sri. OS Pattanad & others. Tea & lunch for the doctors & organizers was arranged by the school. Announcement was made in the school a week prior to the camp

for taking the advantage of free dental checkup & free medicines. Parents were asked to accompany kids during check-up & for medication compliance.

AJET thanks all the doctors for their free service and villagers for active participation and children beneficiaries and other volunteers.

Five (5) needy school children of Jain community were given individual cheque as scholarship to assist in their studies. Mr. Darshan 11th Std, Mr. Bharatesh 11th Std, Mr. Preetham 9th Std, Ms. Pavithra 12th Std and Ms. Ranjitha 8th Std. Total amount of Rs. 20.000/- was distributed.

The camp & scholarship distribution were conducted as the social responsibility projects of the AJE trust

Dr. Suresh opined that today's teachers have to change their teaching strategy to meet the needs of the 21st century learner who is driven by technology. He appreciated the progress & contribution of HESDARC in the last 01 year & agreed to engage actively in the best way possible. Prof. Dharmarajan mentioned about the classical Chaturvarna of Pharm. - Dr. Sekar was the key host who organized the programs in University of Findlay.
- Dr. Milap Nahata was the key host & coordinated the visit in Ohio State University, Columbus
- Dr. Nagavi spoke on "Pharmacy Education & Practice in India and Objectives of HESDAR Center". A video of HESDAR center covering Vision, Mission, activities and progress of the center was shown. The presentation was followed with question & answer session. Participants were pleased to know & appreciated various programs of pharmacy education & large number of institutes with research, hospital & community focus.
